

## MUSICIANS' COORDINATOR (3 Positions)

This position is for one who can recruit music groups for charity fundraising concert events! You must find professional musicians who would like to take part in charity fundraising concert events to benefit charities! C.A.I. is willing to pay you for your work, and this pay would be negotiable to be fair to you and to C.A.I. We hope to eventually be able to purchase an income generating property to produce a sufficient renewable income to help in covering the pay for more musicians as well. If you are a musician also, you may work for C.A.I. in addition to finding other professional musicians! This position could become a full-time paid position, with pay commensurate with that of a professional!

Be your own boss and work hard toward a bright future, and develop a career opportunity! You must find a good number of musical groups that would be happy to take part in charity fundraising concert events so as to raise their profile and to have fun doing so! It would be helpful if you had a computer to make a listing of groups supporting many genres of music you could call upon when an event is being organised. We need groups covering every genre of music there is, such as classical, Blues, Soul, Jazz, Motown, Rock, Country Western, Opera, Reggae, etc. See the C.A.I. poster on the C.A.I. website. This will show you all the different types of music groups we wish to recruit.

Previous experience would be necessary, perhaps even a requirement. You would work closely with the Events Organiser so as to match up musical groups who would take part in the concert events that were planned, and organise the concert with the type of groups you can find. In the beginning we will only be able to put on one concert per month at most, although we hope that eventually with the help of an Events Organiser we would be able to put on weekly events. In the beginning C.A.I. will only be able to put on one concert monthly. If you are a musician, this would be a very big bonus as we would have a position for you too! And if you would be good at finding music groups who could take part in charity fundraising concert events, then that is what is really needed for this position.

The Trustees will do all they can to assist you where possible, although ultimately you must be the one able to find the sort of musicians and groups for the Events Organiser so as to ensure that a wide variety of music will be provided at every charity fundraising concert event. If you are only able to cover a select type of genres of music, we will need another who could work with you providing groups such as those indicated on the C.A.I. Poster. You will determine the order of the programme, and all we need from you is to put together the groups necessary for the events!
