

## SECURITY OFFICER (2 Positions)

Your job would be to watch for any potential trouble makers at charity fundraising concert events, escorting such people from the concert venues. You must have worked previously as a Bouncer for a night club or bar, and be fully conversant with the requirements of being a security guard. You must have all relevant legal documents in place to enable you to work for the C.A.I. Project. You must stand at a height of at least 6' tall, although those who stand even taller will be our first preference. In exchange for your assistance at concert events, you will be paid at a very favourable rate of pay.

In addition to serving as a Security Officer, you will also play a part as a body guard when and as necessary, protecting musicians and C.A.I. Personnel from attacks or anti social behaviour, nuisances or annoyances from other people, and to escort such people from the concert venue. With your assistance, we will purchase any equipment that you will need for your job, and we will reimburse you for any insurance coverage you choose to have in place. You will need to teach us your job too!

This is an opportunity to grow with a new charity until it becomes global! Stick with C.A.I. through its infancy, support it as a member and reap the rewards of being part of what will become an International charity benefitting communities everywhere! Why not be part of a team in a new and exciting charity which gives support to other charities?! Previous experience would be required. You would help with the smooth running of each concert, providing security for the event. You must be early to each concert event by at least 15 minutes, then leave within 15 minutes after the event ends. You will be recognised for your contribution and become a valued member of the C.A.I. team! You will be mentioned on the C.A.I. website for your position and what you do as well!

A suitable candidate would be flexible to do any task needing to be done. You must have common sense and initiative. This position would offer a pay scale of no less than £10 per hour. You would walk about the event and help wherever possible, partially in crowd management as well. It would be a bonus if you were versed in a martial art so as to defend yourself and to disable violent individuals who are intent on causing trouble. You must make a record as to any individuals you may have had to apprehend, banning them from entry at future concert events if necessary. Enjoy listening to concert events free, also with music such as Jazz, Pop, Country Western, Blues, Reggae, Classical, Soul, Motown, Barbershop, you name it! You will meet hundreds of musicians, make dozens of friends, and be recognised for your charitable nature for good and worthy causes while earning a good income!
