You would help in setting up the chairs for the musicians, and selling cups of tea, coffee and biscuits throughout! At concert venues, you will be kept apprised of everything going on, from one concert to the next! After all, you would be included as part of the C.A.I. family! Most concerts will be held on Friday evenings, all day Saturdays and on Sundays. You must help in setting up chairs, music stands etc., assist as necessary in selling refreshments during intervals, then to pack up and put things away at the end of the concert, also help to clean up the venue after each concert event!

This is an excellent opportunity for you to take part in helping with the organisation of concert venues, being a part of the C.A.I. family and enjoying fantastic concert events while keeping track of tasks to be done, whether selling tickets at the door/s, setting things up for the concert, or putting things away and cleaning up at the end of each charity fundraising concert event! Be your own boss, and the pay for this job would be better than for most jobs, just being a member of the C.A.I. family!

This is an opportunity to grow with a new charity until it becomes global! Stick with C.A.I. through its infancy, support it as a member and reap the rewards of being part of what will become an International charity benefitting communities everywhere! Why not be part of a team in a new and exciting charity which gives support to other charities?! Previous experience would be helpful. You would help with the smooth running of each concert, and help to prepare for the event. You must be early to each concert event by at least 30 minutes, then leave within 30 minutes after the event ends. You will be recognised for your contribution and become a valued member of the C.A.I. team! You will be mentioned on the C.A.I. website for your position and what you do as well!

A suitable candidate would be flexible to do any task needing to be done. You must have common sense and initiative. This position would be either voluntary or up to £10 per hour. You would provide the Events Organiser with assistance in setting up each venue for each event, then pack things away at the end! We hope the Candidate will remain loyal and stay with C.A.I. permanently. The Trustees will do all they can to assist if possible, so as to help you. You must assist as necessary in the setting up and packing away of everything needed at each venue. You will enjoy listening to concert events with music such as Jazz, Pop, Country Western, Blues, Reggae, Classical, Soul, Motown, Barbershop, you name it! You will meet hundreds of musicians, make dozens of friends, and be recognised for your charitable nature for good and worthy causes while earning a good income!
